Requirements

- English: Recommended level B1 with a mark of 1 or 90% or IELTS 5.0 (certificate not required)
- Successful completion of high school (final school certificate is required)
- Freshman entrance test or Test AS
- All applicants must take either the entrance exam or TestAS. See our website for test dates and locations.
